There are fairly steep slopes with narrow pavements, some cobbles, so stout walking shoes are advisable



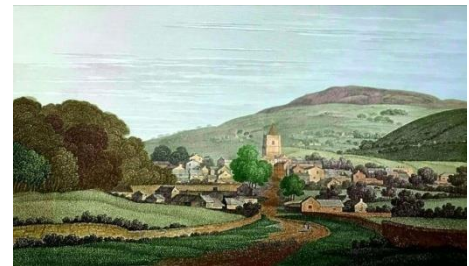
