Long Serving Co-ordinators.



Eleven members of the group were led on a visit to Bakewell Parish Church. Kevin Wagstaffe used his knowledge of the different architectural styles to explain the development of the site from the development of the seventh century Anglo-Saxon settlement until Victorian times. The extensive number of ancient stones gave clues to the importance of the site. Kevin showed the group examples of the Early English, Decorated and Perpendicular architectural building style. The group appreciated his research and careful explanation of the complicated site.

On Tuesday 16th April the group are to visit Hob Hurst's House prehistoric monument on Beeley Moor led by Liz Walker.
